Degree Requirements & Concentrations/Electives

BA Psychology program consists of 36 credits in core courses and 12 credits in courses in a selected area of emphasis to fulfill the 48 credit requirement for the program.

- 3. General Psychology
- 4. Preparation for Advanced Study in Counseling
- 5. Preparation for Advanced Study in Psychology

It is possible for transfer courses to meet course requirements within the emphasis area.
