Degree Requirements & Concentrations/Electives

BA Organizational Leadership consists of 30 credits in core requirements and 12 credits in electives to fulfill the 42 credit requirement for the program.

Students may choose the elective credits from the following areas of study:

Business Administration, Communications, Healthcare Administration, Human Resource Management, Information Technology, Legal Studies, Management, Organizational Leadership, and Psychology.

It is possible for transfer courses to meet course requirements within the emphasis area.
